Worked in Physics Division of Oak Ridge National Laboratory at Theoretical Atomic Physics program since 1995, where he retired as a member of senior research and development staff and project manager at the beginning of 2012. He obtained his Ph.D. at CC of CUNY in 1981 on the theory of multiphoton processes, he got BSC and MSC on the technical physics and technical plasma physics from University of Belgrade. His research covers a wide range of fields in theoretical atomic physics, plasma physics and nuclear fusion, computational physics, plasma-surface interactions, molecular electronics and bionanotechnology, published in more than 200 papers in peer-reviewed journals, 2 patents and more than 80 talks at scientific conferences and seminars. Contributor to the book chapters, editor of a number of conference proceedings, PI and Co-PI on many grants with DOE, NIH, NSF, IAEA, consultant of International Atomic Energy Agency, Fellow of the American Physical Society, international conferences organizer and co-organizer.
